Do you usually consider the durability of a product before purchasing it?

SCI hosted an interactive Environmental Youth Talk with Zeina Al Hashmi, Sustainability Specialist at ADNOC, to shed light on conscious consumerism and sustainable habits that youth can pick up. Zeina spoke about the UN's Sustainable Development Goal 12 on responsible consumption and production, and the UAE's role in achieving objectives that serve this goal. The talk ended with an engaging Q&A followed by insightful guidance on daily actions and areas where students can support and participate in sustainable causes.



Abu Dhabi University professors develop new tools to monitor and detect <u>oil spills</u>

Oil spills cause significant damage to marine life and ecosystems. A team of professors from Abu Dhabi University has studied new ways to monitor and detect oil spills to maintain a safe and clean environment while protecting marine life. Professors Reem Salim, Hadil Abu Khalifeh, Adel Khelifi and Mohammed Ghazal focused on synthetic aperture radar sensors, which can be attached to aircrafts and satellites, to obtain images of sea and land surfaces. This proposed fast and highly precise image segmentation method can help to accurately identify oil spills from other land and marine related activities. Professor Mohamed Ghazal, Professor and Chair of the Electrical and Computer Engineering Department at ADU said, "This research project provides important insights which can help the environment and are particularly important to the UAE, as a global leader in the production and transportation of oil". **Well done on this initiative!**
