Higher Colleges of Technology Participated in Global Manufacturing & Industrialisation Summit 2021 in Expo 2020

The Sustainability session of the Global Manufacturing & Industrialisation Summit 2021 (GMIS), was held at the Dubai Exhibition Centre at EXPO 2020. H.E Professor Abdullatif Al Shamsi, HCT President & CEO was part of the discussion panel about "The role of educational institutions in addressing climate & environmental challenges, through awareness & research".

Discussing Environmental Sustainability Challenges including climate change and reiterating the importance of Environmental Sustainability strategies in the UAE and the continuous efforts done to follow best practices and adopt innovative ideas that support achieving environmental sustainability to prepare for hosting Heads of State and government leaders at COP28 international climate summit in 2023.

Prof. Al Shamsi mentioned that HCT is the largest academic organization in the UAE and sustainability is a crucial element in its strategy which is extended to both its organisational and academic level. HCT also conducted various projects that aim to reduce energy consumption, efficient use of water, reduction of Co2 emissions, and green building Initiative at a training and education level.

HCT ensured a training about sustainability concepts and promoted it within the campus and was open to all staff and admin, 1268 of them completed 3630 hours of training in the field. In addition, Climate change, research and environmental topics including sustainable design and renewable energy systems, introduction to sustainability, and

environmental engineering were included in the curriculum. These have benefited 7,106 students to date.

Prof. Al Shamsi added that HCT is also promoting applied research and innovative student projects related to environmental sustainability.

HCT received many prestigious regional and global sustainability-related awards, including the Green Organization's Green World Award, in the sustainability in education and training category, for applying environmental best practices in sustainable education, innovation and technology in sustainability. It also won three major awards at the Gulf Sustainability and CSR Awards 2021, for its efforts and its commitment to applying best global practices in sustainability and enhancing the welfare and wellbeing of its employees.

He also highlighted the importance of raising young students' awareness of the future challenges to climate and environmental changes, their impact on human lives, and the national and global efforts and strategies to address those

challenges. Prof. Al Shamsi highlighted students' prospective role as future leaders in bringing about positive change and creating initiatives to support environmental sustainability for a better planet, to be enjoyed by generations to come.
