## Resetting our relationship with planet Earth

Every year on June 5th, people around the world recognise World Environment Day and the time to reimagine, recreate, and restore. Although we cannot turn back time and the damages sustained by our planet, this year youth are joining forces under the theme #GenerationRestoration to make peace with nature and uptake green practices for a healthier ecosystem.

Zero waste, GHG emissions reduction, and restored forests are all ambitious goals that countries have set, and although they may seem out of reach, small steps lead to incredible change. To kick-start your own change today, here are 3 ideas to help restore nature:

- 1. Grow your own vegetables and herbs in your balcony or backyard to reduce up to 20% of your food purchases and reduce 30.8kg of Co2 emission a year.
- 2. Reuse food waste and convert it into compost.
- 3. Plant ghaf trees, a single ghaf tree can reduce up to 34.65 Kg of Co2 emissions per year.
